# Inspiring story of the month

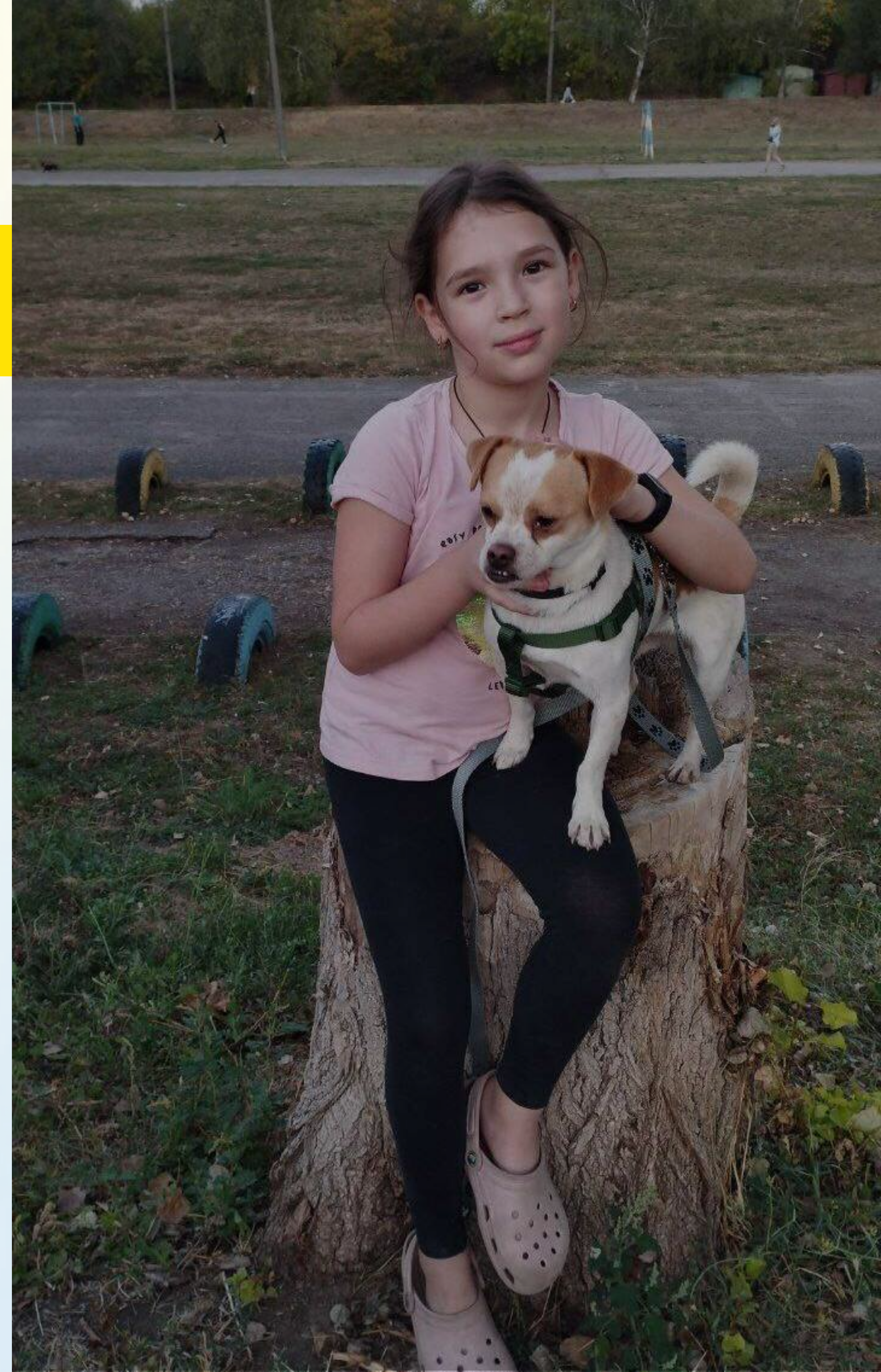
**"He promised his wife and two daughters that he would definitely return. And not alone, with a dog."**

- Artem Dementiy, a fighter from Zaporizhzhia, picked up a dog at the front and took care of it. But in May of this year, the 33-year-old soldier was killed in a battle in Donetsk region from shrapnel wounds. Kateryna's wife later decided to find her beloved's four-legged friend. Now the dog named "Click" lives in the Hero's family and **serves as a reminder** of her husband's kind heart.

8-year-old Victoria, the daughter of the fallen soldier, can no longer imagine her life without the dog, who became **a breath of fresh air** for her after her father's death.

Less than three months have passed since the two daughters of the Hero, the younger Mariana and the older Vika, became wards of the Children of Heroes Charity Foundation. During this time, the family received food packages from us and a hygiene kit from our partner Biosphere. Little Mariana received clothes from Reima. And Vika is happy to use the stationery and backpack she received.

We are happy that we can **make the world a brighter place** for Mariana, Vika and all other children who have lost their parents and need our support.

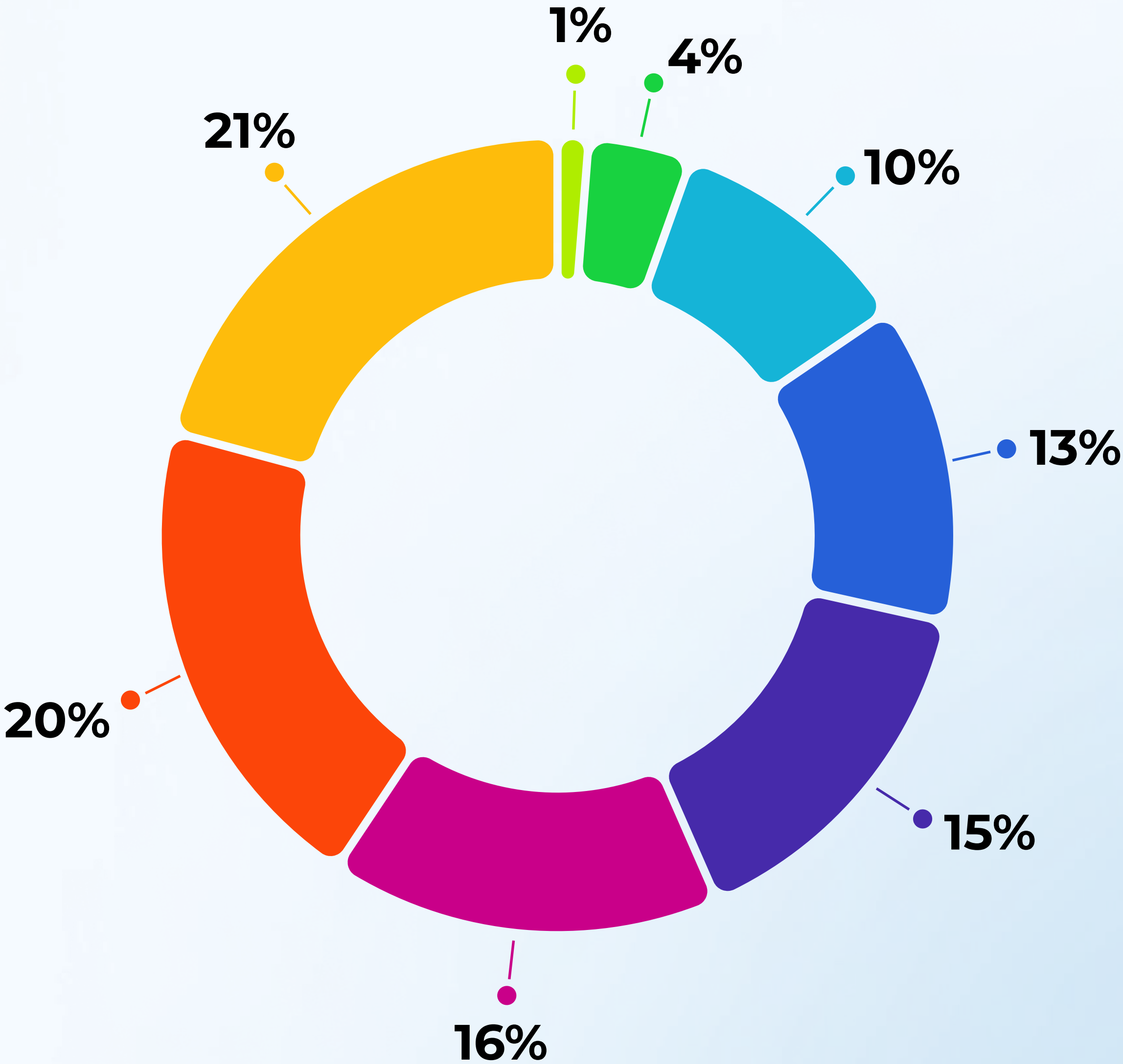

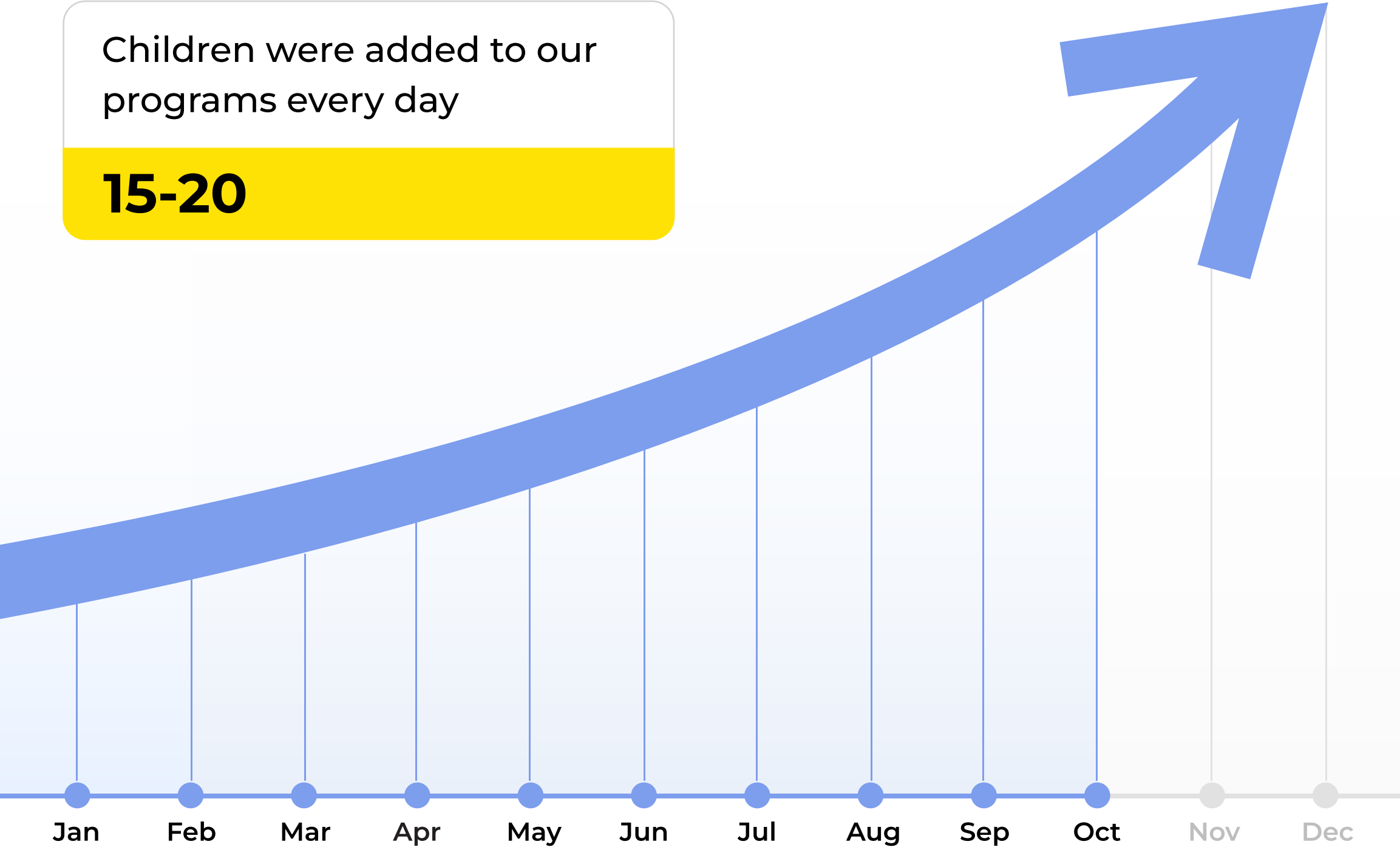
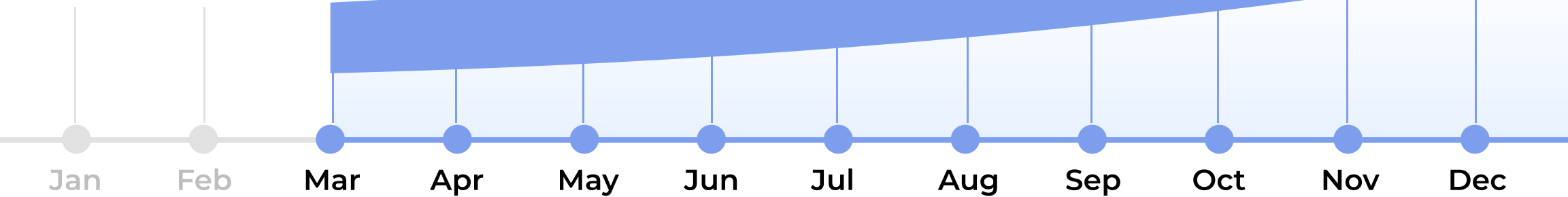
