





Inspiring story of the month

Dasha, 14 years

Dasha has cerebral palsy. All her life, the girl makes a lot of effort to train her body. The war took the life of Dasha's father Oleg. He was a border guard and died defending Ukraine in the Luhansk region. Since then, Dasha has been cared for only by her mother. From the Foundation, the girl received food kits, first-aid kits, clothes, shoes and a laptop, thanks to which the girl performs health exercises online.

And recently, Dasha received a wheelchair from the foundation. The family's joy and happiness knew no bounds. Now Dasha can move independently, spend more time in the fresh air. Life has been filled with new opportunities, for which Dasha is infinitely grateful.




Programs of support







