Thanks to the Binance company, the "Ya-da Vinci" camp will be implemented in June, focusing on the psychological recovery of children and their guardians. There will be a shift for 30 children and 30 caregivers, which will provide them not only with rest, but also with intensive psychological support. The initiative creates a safe environment where participants can work on their own emotional well-being and recovery, becoming stronger and resilient to the challenges of the future.





17 300 USD for the camp from Razom for Ukraine

Thanks to Razom for Ukraine, an educational journalism camp "Ukraine Today" will be organised. This camp will provide a unique opportunity for 35 teenagers to gain journalistic skills and understand modern media spaces. The camp will take place from 20 to 28 May in the picturesque city of Yaremche. In addition to an intensive recreation programme, the children will communicate with journalists who will demonstrate the basic principles of a modern newsman.





1385 first aid kits from Teva

The Children of Heroes of Ukraine Foundation is grateful to announce the successful completion of the humanitarian mission thanks to the support of Teva. We have sent 1072 medical kits, which have met the basic medical needs of 1576 children from 1072 families across Ukraine.


Inspiring story of the month

Vika, Maryana and their mother Kateryna

Mother Kateryna and her daughters Vika (age 8) and Maryana (age 2) live in Zaporizhzhia. Their father, Artem, served in the 72nd brigade and died in the war. Artem found the dog in the Donetsk area, where he served. The tailed one was called "Klyk". "He took care of him, fed him, bathed him, took care of him and made videos for us. The dog is so funny that we fell in love with him already from the video and the girls really asked to bring him home." But the man did not have time.

After losing her husband, Kateryna decided to find her lover's dog. Klyk was found in Kropyvnytskyi, but it turned out that another family had already taken him. But the family agreed to return it to the girls, moved by their story. The dog has been next to Artyom's two daughters for half a year now, as their father wanted. The clique quickly became part of the family and became especially attached to Vika, who became his new owner.

Anton Ptushkin's film "We, our pets and the war", dedicated to Artem Dementiy, was recently released in Ukrainian cinemas. Vika and Kateryna took part in filming. But the most valuable thing is that they saw their dad there. Unique shots with Artyom and his friend Klyk are forever preserved in the film.




Programs of support





