15 000 USD from Nova Ukraine

Thanks to a \$15,000 grant from Nova Ukraine, we successfully held a Smart Money Camp for 35 children. For 10 days in September, the children participated in personal finance trainings, learned about world currencies and the basics of investing. In addition to training, the participants participated in master classes, sports activities, and gatherings around the campfire with a guitar. It was an incredible experience that combined learning and outdoor activities, helping children develop new skills and confidence.





2 800 000 UAH from Puma Ukraine and Shakhtar

The Forever Faster Kids sports camp became an important event for 130 children thanks to the support of Puma Ukraine and the Charity Organization "Shakhtar Social". The total amount of support amounted to UAH 2,766,500 of which UAH 500,000 was provided by Shakhtar Social while the rest of the funding came from Puma Ukraine. The camp program was aimed at developing sports skills, teamwork and a healthy lifestyle, and created great opportunities for children to make new friends and be inspired to achieve new goals.







32 574 EUR from Ein Herz Fur Kinder

Ein Herz Fur Kinder provided 32,574 euros to organize Wonder Camp in September, a camp for 50 children that became a space for psychological support and recovery. For 12 days, the children received qualified therapy, participated in group and individual sessions, and experienced the joy of childhood.

School year 2024

As part of the project to prepare for the school year 2024, 3855 children were provided with stationery sets through joint efforts.

1512 sets were purchased with funds provided by Aurora
1963 sets from Vivat, including 500 for first-graders (with a backpack),
1200 for grades 2-5 and 263 for fifth-graders (with a backpack)
240 sets from our partner BGK
282 sets from Metro
93 sets from the Heart of Azovstal Foundation for families of Azov
employees

Additionally, our other partners provided a total of 232 kits, including contributions from Caritas Kharkiv, Shkolaryk, Tetrada and other donors. BIC also provided us with 2,880 pencils and 2,820 pens to complete the sets.

This joint support allowed us to prepare the children for the new school year with high quality, providing them with everything they need for effective learning.



Preparing for school from Vivat

We are grateful to our partner Vivat for supporting the children of the Foundation and providing them with everything they need for effective learning. Your support makes our children's education more comfortable and productive!

Thanks to your help, we were able to provide:

- 510 sets of stationery and backpacks;

Inspiring story of the month

Yana, 4 years old

Yana is from Ivano-Frankivsk. Her father was a soldier and was killed on April 9, 2022, during a mortar attack while serving in the Armed Forces of Ukraine. Yana was not yet two years old.

In difficult times, Yana's mother, Svetlana, repeatedly sought psychological support from the specialists provided by the Foundation. This help has become an important part of their family's recovery. Today, Yana and Svetlana lead an active life. Yana is studying at a modeling school and attends dance classes. The Foundation provided the family with comprehensive assistance, in particular through the projects "Warmth for Children" (blanket) and "Light for Children" (power bank), as well as humanitarian aid: clothes, food and hygiene kits. In addition, the family received gifts for the holidays and is now waiting for medical support.

We are deeply inspired by the strength and resilience of Yana and her mother Svetlana. The photo shows Yana participating in the "Running for a Hero" race in Ivano-Frankivsk, where they ran 2 km in memory of their father.


Programs of support

Education and development - various programs aimed at comprehensive development of children

























Financial report


